

Counselor In Training Program

The CIT program is for eligible students going into 9th, 10th, 11th & 12th grade, who wish to learn leadership skills and be role models for our young campers. We are looking for responsible and respectful applicants who possess some fun-loving spirit!

Students accepted into the CIT program will shadow counselors during their shifts and assist in the daily running of camp. This includes facilitation of camper activities, preparation of lunch & snack, playground supervision, field trip group assistance, and more. CIT's are expected to be positive and caring role models to our campers; participating in games, helping campers in need, etc.

Qualifying applicants who are admitted to the program will receive...

- A Camp Shirt
- Weekly Leadership Training Courses
- Credit for Volunteer Hours

CIT's will be given a schedule based on their submitted availability. CIT's are expected to attend all of their scheduled shifts, unannounced absences could result in dismissal from the program. The program is tuition free, however CITs must cover the cost of field trip entrance fees (see CIT field trip form).

Applications are due by **Friday, April 30th, 2021**. Forms received after the deadline will not be considered for the CIT program. Decisions will be made after reviewing all applications and after interviews have been completed. CIT Selection will be complete by mid May; emails will be sent to notify applicants of their status. Once an application is submitted, please wait to hear back as to when your interview will be scheduled.
