

Aloha Hephatha Families!

The metrics in our County have continued to go down... God is so good! With this in mind, we are cautiously-optimistic in our summer planning, and continue to make the safety and well-being of your child, our staff and our faculty our number one priority!

Please take a moment to read through the summer protocols thoroughly:

1. We will continue disinfecting our entire school before the arrival of your children, and will continue to follow the state guidelines of cleaning and disinfecting daily.
2. We will be taking the temperature of each child and staff member upon arrival. If your child presents with a fever (99.9 or above), they will not be permitted to attend camp, and they must be fever-free for a full 24 hours before they can return to camp. Please be extra-mindful of your child's health, and keep them home if you think they may not be feeling well.
3. We are excited to announce that parents will be able to drop their campers off directly to their classrooms this summer! While this news is huge for the community feel of our campus, this privilege comes with some teamwork caveats... but we know we can count on your teamwork to make this dream work! :)
 - a. Please keep drop-offs and pick-ups as short as possible: save discussions with other parents for off-campus, and unfortunately, there can be no hanging back to let siblings to play on the playground;
 - b. Please observe social distancing, and wear your mask at all times when you are on campus;
 - c. Your gate code will work at normal pick-up and drop-off times; please do not show up earlier than your camper's program start time.
 - d. Your gate code for the summer will be **487612**. *Please do not share this code with anyone*, unless they are listed on your Emergency Form, and picking-up/dropping-off in your place;
 - e. Please find a way to ensure that you will not find yourself at the gate without your code, as keeping our ratio makes it dangerous for teachers to leave their post to let you through the gate. Likewise, the Administration Office hours are very limited over the summer (M-Th only, 9am to 3pm).
 - f. We will take this on a session-to-session basis, while keeping an eye on the metrics in our county, as well as the safety of our staff, faculty and families. If there is anything we have all learned this year, it is patience and *balance!* :) We are confident that we can find that balance between safety guidelines, and keeping the community feel that is Hephatha's trademark.
4. Please be sure to sign your child in and out with a legible signature.
5. Students, staff and faculty will only be required to wear a mask when indoors, as we need to follow California State Licensing guidelines.
6. Camp Keiki's hours of operation are **7am to 5pm**. The drop-off and pick-up times will be as follows:
Morning drop-off will be between 7-9:15am. If we are not at the gate when you arrive, please use the "Ring".
Three pick-up times: 1pm, 3pm, and 5pm. It is important that you adhere to these times, so the program can stay in ratio while a staff member is at the gate. If you have to pick your child up at a different time, please call **714-637-0887 ext. 125, or ext. 153 to make arrangements**, or use the "Ring" at the main gate.
7. If your child is in a 3pm or 5pm program, their Rollee-Pollee™ will be kept in a separate bag, and **MUST** be taken home at the end of the week for laundering, and brought back to camp the following week. Your child's mat will be labeled with his or her name.
8. Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack, sack lunch in disposable bag daily.
